**DO YOU SHOP AT SAINSBURY'S?** As a Fair Trade parish, we should all be concerned that Sainsbury's, which has been in the forefront of Championing Fair Trade in recent years, has decide to abandon its support of the Fair Trade Mark- the internationally recognised and monitored guarantee that a product conforms to Fair Trade standards- and is replacing the mark with its own 'fairly traded' logo. This threatens to undermine the functioning of the respected Fair Trade Foundation, and will lead to uncertainty as to whether products really are fairly traded as different supermarkets set up their own 'fair trade' brands, monitored only by themselves. Please complain to Sainsbury's, don't buy their alternative fair trade brand products, and google 'Don't ditch Fair Trade' to learn more.

**CENTENARY of FATIMA APPARITIONS:** On **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October** it will be **100** years since the final apparition made by Our Blessed Lady to the three children of **Fatima**. At this apparition, Our Blessed Lady let the children, Lucia, **Jacinta and Francisco** and those present in Fatima as well as for many miles around the great miracle of the **Sun** at which people were able to look directly at the sun without damage to their eyes and at which the sun spun in the sky and then hurtled towards the earth. This was the final apparition in Fatima but the miracle of Fatima and the apparitions of our Blessed Lady and the prophecies she gave have been the defining marks of the last **100 years**, what is next we must pray for God's mercy and grace that it be good for us and the Church and for our salvation. To mark this centenary, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in church at **10.am on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October** whilst the **Rosary** is said for peace, the **Holy Mass** will be said in honour of our **Blessed Lady and the three children of Fatima**. This will be followed by a **light lunch in the Parish Hall** followed by a **DVD** on the apparitions of Fatima and what they mean for all of us. Please try and come along and help us to make a fitting tribute to God and his Holy Mother and a thanksgiving for his continued love for us and our families.
