The Sacrament of Confirmation

The preparation for any sacrament is a very special time in the moral and spiritual development of young people. The programme used here within the Parish promotes active co-operation between parents, catechists, priests and the entire parish community, whilst recognising the central role of parents as the prime educators in a child's religious development.

As parents we should be the best educators of our children, particularly in the ways of their faith. We do this through our regular practice and the living out of our own faith. All this is part of the Sacramental preparation and for this reason, preparation needs to be a true family journey. Also, working through the course with their child gives parents an opportunity to rediscover their own faith. This is truly a God given opportunity.

What does the course involve?

The young people are prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation by coming along to sessions held at the church. The programme giving times and dates will be given to all parents whose children enrol for the instruction.

Preparation for the course is given in the Post-Holy Communion Course that the applicant should be attending and by continuing commitment to Sunday Mass by attending regularly. This course starts in September and is a two year course. There are separate sessions during the course for parents.

The young people, providing they are considered to be ready by the catechists and providing they have shown that they and their parents have been regular attenders at Sunday mass and that the candidates have been regular attenders at the instruction sessions will be put forward to the parish priest with the request that their names be put forward to the Bishop for Confirmation. Dates for the conferring of the sacrament of Confirmation by the Bishop will be given to each family as soon as they are available.

Thoughts for Parents & Guardians to ponder

This is a special time in the spiritual development of my child. Perhaps now is the time to think through my own values and attitudes:

- Is there any unsolved problem in my own life that I need to put in order?
- By my actions, what am I teaching my child about their faith?
- Do I take my child to mass on a regular basis?
- Do I pray with my child?
- What do I want for my child?
- Do I practically support my child in their growth in faith?
- Do I understand the true meaning of these sacraments and do I use them regularly myself?

If you would like to talk to anyone about these or any other questions you may have, a member of the catechetical team or the parish priest would be only too pleased to give you time.

What do I do next?

Simply fill in the attached form and hand it in to the parish priest or one of the catechists after mass in ordered to be registered for the next course. Alternatively drop the form into the Presbytery. Courses are run annually but take two years to complete. Please bring your child's Baptismal certificate to the first meeting.
